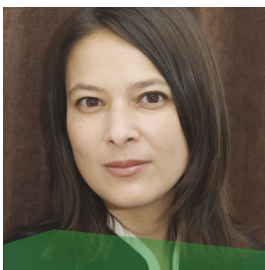
Human Rights Watch's Elaine Pearson
